Annual Award for 2022

Information and How to Enter

The Cleveland Institution of Engineers holds an annual competition for the best written paper. The paper has to cover a topic related to Engineering, Materials Science, Plant or Processes relevant to the Teesside area. The competition sponsored by the Materials Processing Institute, is open to members of all local Engineering organizations, local educational establishments and qualified private individuals. There is no age limit.

The prize for the winning paper is £400 cash with a prize of £100 for the runner-up. The winner's prize is payable after the paper has been presented at a CIE general meeting.

Initial abstracts of approximately 500 words should be submitted to the CIE by **1st of August 2022**. Judging of the abstracts will take four weeks from the deadline. From the abstracts two individuals will be asked to complete a full paper for the **30th of October 2022**.

These will then be judged and a winner selected to present the paper in the 2022/23 CIE Programme season.

Cleveland Institution of Engineers Annual Award Rules

1. The Award will be presented annually for the best written paper covering Engineering, Materials Science, Plant or Processes relevant to the Teesside area.
2. Entrants can be from any regional Engineering organization, local educational establishment or be private individuals.
3. Competition consists of two stages:-
 - 3.1 Initial abstracts of approximately 500 words each, submitted to the Technical Events Officer of the CIE, by **1st August 2022**.
 - 3.2 Notified finalists to submit full papers of up to 5000 words for a scientific paper or up to 10,000 words from a review paper, by the **30th of October 2022** to a CIE panel which will select the winner.
4. The paper must either be new and unpublished or published within the last 12 months.
5. The CIE Judging panel will consist of at least three people including the CIE President, if he/she wishes and at least one external independent member. There will be a maximum of one person per single organization or company.
6. The winner must present his/her paper at a General Meeting of the Cleveland Institution of Engineers, on a date to be arranged in the 2022-2023 Session, which runs from October 2022 to May 2023 to qualify for the award.
 - 6.1 No prize money will be paid until the presentation of the paper to a CIE general meeting has taken place
7. The prize for this award is £400, with a runner-up prize of £100

Applicants please note: *The CIE holds this competition in the highest regard, and will only confer the CIE award to a paper which meets the exacting standards we expect of such a prestigious award. The CIE reserves the right to not give the award if, in the opinion of the judges, no paper submitted is of the standard to merit the award. The opinion of the judging panel is final. Any applicant whose paper has not won the award is welcome to apply in subsequent years, providing the entry rule criteria can be satisfied.*
